Minutes of last meeting were read and approved – motion by LeRoy w/second by V.P. Brophy

Treasurer's Report by Jackie Collins:

Treasurer Collins reported that our funds should increase with addition of new members and the expected renewals.

Committee reports: President Llama reported that the spring skeet league will start next week. Currently there are no chairs for the Trap & Fishing committees.

Trophy committee chairman LeRoy reminded members about participation in the trophy awards program...President Llama thanked Director LeRoy for his long years of work as head of the Trophy Committee.

Ed White of the Pheasant Committee made a motion that the club buys a twenty-bird card from Birds Landing. Seconded by V.P. Brophy – it carried unanimously.

Ed White briefly discussed the Action Pistol & Steel Challenge programs of Diablo Gun Club.

Unfinished business: President Llama reported that the Rifle & Pistol Ranges should be open in 6 months.

Preparatory to the changing of Bylaw 4.09 Secretary Collins read it as it is currently and read the change proposed. This was second reading of the change to 4.09 in back-to-back meetings. (Currently 4.09 reads, "The President, with approval of the Board, shall appoint no later than March of each year, a nominating committee of at least two members in good standing, whose duties shall be to present the names of candidates to each elective office. These names shall be submitted to the membership at the general meeting in May and shall be voted on at the general membership meeting in June.

Nominations for all elective offices shall also be open from the floor at the time of election.

The motioned change to 4.09 would read, "The president, with the approval of the Board shall appoint no later than March of each year, a nominating committee of at least two members in good standing, whose duties shall be to present the names of candidates of each elective office,

these names shall be submitted to the membership at the general membership meeting in June. Nominations for all elective offices shall be closed at the meeting prior to the election meeting.)

Barry Cunningham reported the Bylaws Committee met last month and that certain changes to the Bylaws and the Policies & Procedures will be proposed at the membership meeting next month.

Old Business: The nominating committee was not present so President asked the membership if they had anyone they wanted to nominate...There was no in-put.

There was discussion about moving the membership meetings to Sunday

Nights the idea was well received, but it needs more work. Bill Vencill suggested a “survey monkey” to see how the general membership feels about such a change.

There was discussion about the need for a membership chairman.
