Bay Point Rod & Gun Club Membership Meeting Minutes 5/07/19

The meeting was called to order at 8:00pm by President Llama. Barry Cunningham led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: President Llama, Vice President Brophy, Treasurer Jackie Collins, and Secretary Ed Collins were present as were 17 club members.

The minutes of last months meeting were read by secretary Ed Collins and approved by the membership.

Committee Reports:

President Llama gave a brief report on the current skeet league.

President Llama requested help from anyone interested in starting a Trap League.

There is no fishing chairman at the moment.

Unfinished Business:

Secretary Ed Collins read Section 4.09 of the Bylaws for the third time in successive meetings. This was done in order to properly change Section 4.09. The Section is written as follows: "The President, with approval of the Board, shall appoint no later than March of each year, a nominating committee of at least two members in good standing, whose duties shall be to present the names of candidates for each elective office. These names shall be submitted to the membership at the general membership meeting in May and shall be voted on at the general membership meeting in June. Nominations for all elective offices shall also be open from the floor at the time of election. "

Secretary Ed Collins then read the proposed change to Bylaw Section 4.09. Again this was the third reading in successive club meetings. The proposed Bylaw change as motioned at the March 16th meeting, "The President, with approval of the Board, shall appoint no later than March of each year, a nominating committee of at least two members in good standing, whose duties shall be to present the names of candidates for each elective office. These names shall be submitted to the membership at the general membership meeting in May and shall be voted on at the general membership meeting in June. Nominations for all elective offices shall be closed at the meeting prior to the election meeting.

Vice President Brophy motioned that the change to Bylaw Section 4.09 be adopted. Bill Vencill gave the second. The vote was called and the motion passed with 15 members in favor and 1 member opposed.

Nomination committee:

As to the coming year, Nomination Committee Chairman Ron McCurry addressed the

membership present and opened the nominations for the offices of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Board of Directors. Outside of the current officers and directors no one else expressed interest in the positions. Chairman McCurry then nominated Peter Llama for president, Richard Brophy for vice president, Jackie Collins for treasurer and Ed Collins for secretary. Chairman McCurry also nominated current Directors Gary LeRoy and Dorothy Bayer to the Board of Directors. Ms. Bayer and Mr. LeRoy were not present, but it was assumed that they would continue on... As per Section 4.09 of the Bylaws all nominations were closed at the close of this meeting.

Old Business:

There was discussion about changing the club meetings to the second Sunday of the month, subsequently Vice President Brophy motioned that the meetings be changed. Mike McIntosh seconded the motion. The vote was called and the motion carried with 15 members in favor and 2 members opposed.

President Llama reported that the construction of the Rifle & Pistol ranges is making good progress in spite of losing 6-7 days to bad weather.
